Disciplinary Procedures

If a student does not comply with the Institute rules and the laws of New Zealand, the Institute reserves the right to suspend or expel the student. Students will normally be given one verbal warning and two written warnings in an attempt to remedy the problem prior to expulsion. In any case where a student is in breach of New Zealand law, then expulsion is immediate. No refund of fees will be made.

Payment and Fees

In signing this enrolment form you undertake to pay all fees by the payment date on invoice. WIOL reserves the right to amend its fees. Failure to pay course fees within this exact time frame, will result in your placement being cancelled immediately.

Refund Policy

A student may be eligible for a refund of 80% of the course fee paid, only if the student withdraws and requests a refund in writing at least **3 weeks** before the class start date.

- If the School withdraws an Offer of Place, or is unable to provide the course, all tuition fees are fully refundable.
- A notice of withdrawal due to exceptional circumstances may be accepted as grounds for a refund of **80%** of tuition fees. This is subject to the provision of acceptable documentary evidence in support of the application for the refund, and subject to the date the School Administration Manager received written notice of withdrawal.

This includes:

- Inability to obtain the appropriate visa required for entry into New Zealand;
- Serious illness or disability of the student;
- Death of a student or close family member (parent, sibling, spouse or child);
- Political, civil or natural event that prevents arrival of the student.

No Refunds

- The School will not refund the tuition fees of any student whose Offer of Place is withdrawn through the supplying of incorrect and/or fraudulent documentation.
- The School will not refund the tuition fees of any student who is removed from the School roll through non attendance and / or is expelled by the Wesley Institute of Learning.

Compulsory Insurance for International Nurses

Indemnity insurance

Students are expected to have Indemnity Insurance cover before commencing nursing practice experience. The students must have indemnity insurance before the clinical practise commences. The NZNO has student coverage for **\$44.30 (NZ\$)** This is compulsory and has to be paid on line prior to start of CAP. Please email us your membership document or receipt letter when you have received it from NZNO.

Travel/Medical Insurance

Students in NZ on a visitors or student visa must provide Wesley Institute with an Insurance certificate showing they have arranged travel/medical insurance covering them while completing the CAP course.

Attendance and Behaviour

You will be expected to attend classes and to behave in a responsible manner at WIOL. If your attendance does not meet WIOL requirements of if your behaviour is detrimental to the school or other students, you may be asked to leave the school. In this event your tuition fees will not be refunded. If you need to work or be in paid employment during the duration of the Wesley CAP course it is vital that you advise the Wesley School Manager of your intentions.
